Dear Y11 Parents, Carers and Students,

I am writing to you to let you know that, in line with many other schools across the country, due to the current turbulent situation with coronavirus, we have taken the difficult decision to email the GCSE grades to each student on Thursday 20 August, rather than have them coming into school to collect them.

Whilst it would be wonderful to see all the students face to face, and I know there may be disappointment amongst the students who perhaps have not seen one another for a long time, we feel that, this year, it is the safest decision for everyone concerned - the students, the staff, and all their families.

Results slips will be posted and you can also access your results on the Edulink App and Website using the exams button. These will be accessible from 8:00am. The GCSE grades are those which have been sent to us by Ofqual. The grade awarded will be whichever was the higher between the Centre Assessed (Teacher) grade or the grade calculated by the Ofqual algorithm.

The Rodillian Leadership Team will be in school on Thursday and Friday and will contact every student to offer support and guidance on their next steps, once they have received their grades.

I know that this has been a very difficult year, particularly for Y11 students who have been unable to sit such important exams after a very positive start to their year in the Autumn and early part of the Spring terms. I also know that the resilience they have developed during their years with us will stand them all in good stead for whatever their futures hold, and I wish them much good fortune.

I look forward to seeing many students when you return in Year 12 on Wednesday 2 September, and further information will follow regarding this.
