In other news, Frankie also took part in the individual Junior Kangaroo competition (a follow on round to the UKMT Junior Maths Challenge) where he achieved an excellent 86 marks (only 2 questions short of achieving the highest award of a Merit).

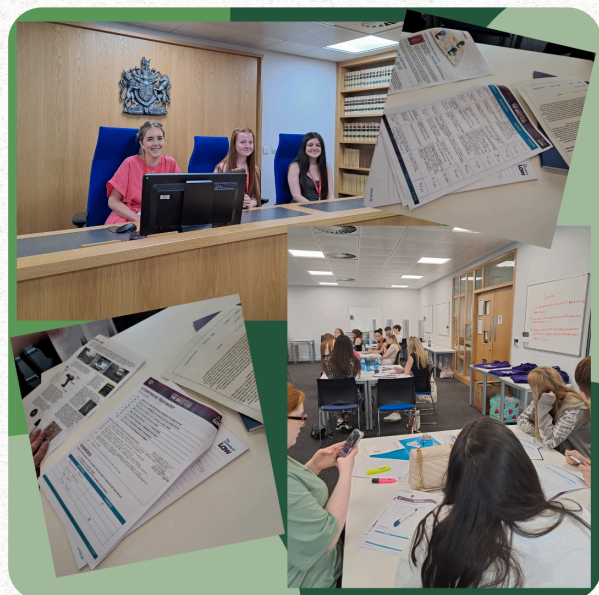
