

# Media Apps – Safeguarding Dec 2025



## **JusTalk free social media app**

### **Why are we concerned?**

- JusTalk has been flagged for weak security settings, which can make accounts vulnerable.
- The app allows contact with strangers, increasing the risk of inappropriate messages or grooming.
- There is limited moderation, meaning harmful content can be shared.

### **What can you do?**

- Speak to your child about the risks of using JusTalk and encourage them to avoid sharing personal information or images.
- Check their devices regularly and ensure privacy settings are enabled on all apps they use.
- If you have any concerns or discover inappropriate contact, please report it immediately to the academy and, if necessary, to the police.



## **Fantasy Premier League forfeit challenges**

### **Why are we concerned?**

- Some students are engaging in ‘forfeit challenges’ linked to Fantasy Premier League, where losing players must complete tasks.
- These challenges can escalate into unsafe, humiliating or harmful activities, especially if shared online.
- Participation can lead to reputational damage and further instances of peer pressure, as well as the potential impact on pupils’ physical and/or mental wellbeing.

### **What can you do?**

- Discuss with your child the importance of respectful and safe behaviour, including online.
- Monitor any group chats or social media linked to Fantasy Premier League and/or these challenges.
- Encourage your child to speak to a trusted adult if they feel pressured or uncomfortable.
